



Rule #1: HAVE FUN!

(Don't talk about fight club)

Board Distance

The MVP League distance from front end to front end of the boards is 23 feet. The distance will be set prior to your game by an MVP staff member.

Game Objective

The first team to land on 21 points wins. MVP plays “bust” meaning you cannot exceed 21. In the event you go over 21 points your team will “bust” and automatically go back to 15 points.

Game Play

- 2 vs. 2
- Teammates will stand at opposite cornhole boards inside the “pitchers box” parallel to each other. The “pitchers box” is the left or right side of the length of the cornhole board.
- To start a game: 2 players will “rock, paper, scissor.” The winner will choose to shoot first/last **OR** which side their team throws from.
- Each team will shoot 4 Cornhole Bags, alternating shots.
- The team who most recently scored points shoots first.
- In the event a team “busts,” they will shoot first.
- You will play 3 matches per night.
- Each match will go towards your overall standings. Meaning: While you’re playing 3 games a night, it is not best 2 out of 3. All 3 matches count.
- You must report your match results to an MVP staff member before you leave.



Scoring

- 1 bag on the board = 1 point
- 1 bag in the hole = 3 points
- To score points towards your overall total: The team with the most points will subtract the opponent's points and the difference will go towards their overall team score. For example: Team A has 2 bags on the board and 1 in the hole = 5 points. Team B has 1 bag on the board and 2 in the hole = 7 points. Team B will be awarded 2 points.

Game Rules

- When throwing you must remain behind the front of the cornhole board, also known as the “pitchers box.”
- When throwing you must remain on your assigned side (right or left of the cornhole board).
- If a bag is thrown and bounces on the ground and onto a cornhole board, that bag is to be removed from the board before the next throw and does not count for scoring.
- If a bag is hanging on the front edge and appears to be supported by the ground, the front of the board is to be slightly lifted **after all 8 bags have been thrown**. If the bag remains on the board it counts as a point. If it falls off it does not count.

Tournament

All teams will make the (8th week) tournament. It will be a single elimination playoff. The regular season results will determine the tournament seeding.
